In early June, we entered Phase 5 and IDPH removed capacity restrictions. In response to this, we ended the pool reservation requirement, allowed guests back to the pool and reinstated awning rentals for parties. This return to normal included swim team hosting its first home swim meet in 2 years with great success, thanks to the Swim Committee, coaches, lifeguards, volunteers and families. Swim lessons for the little ones are also in full swing, with the largest participation with over 30 swimmers. And early morning adult lap swim hosted by Barrington Masters is keeping the pool an active venue from dawn until dusk.

In the coming weeks, the pool check-in process for OPEN SWIM will revert back to the Omnify system and we will move away from the current handwritten process.

- All attendees must be entered into the Omnify system, including residents AND guests.
- To avoid delays at check-in, be sure to complete the one-time setup in Subscriptions under Fox Point Resident
- Guests should be entered as Family Members, where they will be identified as fee or non-fee paying
- Daily guest passes should be purchased using the Omnify Subscriptions page
- A QR code will be posted for self-checkin. Just scan the code posted at the front desk and check you and your party in
